
QUICK START GUIDE: PETROL WATER BLASTERS

SAFETY MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES

- This machine can cause severe injury if the water jet is pointed at any party of the body.
- **ALWAYS** wear protective goggles and suitable protective clothing when operating appliance. Non-slip rubber footwear must be worn when operating the machine.
- Petrol fumes are dangerous, use machine in a well ventilated area.

START UP PROCEDURES

- 1) Ensure gun and lance are connected.
- 2) Connect water blaster to and turn on water supply
- 3) Check for leaks
- 4) Turn **ON** fuel
- 5) Pull trigger on gun to let air escape from the line
- 6) Put choke on, if first start of the day
- 7) Turn **ON** electrical switch on the side of the motor
- 8) Keep trigger of gun pulled and start
- 9) With trigger pulled, slowly push in choke
- 10) Allow machine to warm up before applying full revs
- 11) **NEVER LEAVE THE MACHINE RUNNING WITHOUT THE TRIGGER PULLED FOR MORE THAN 2 - 4 MINUTES!**

SHUT DOWN PROCEDURES

- 1) Drop machine to an idle
- 2) Turn **OFF** electrical switch on the side of the motor
- 3) Pull trigger to release pressure in system
- 4) Turn **OFF** fuel

Remember:

- Check oil level regularly in the motor and the pump
- Use Pump oil only in the pump (not motor oil)
- Sit machines on level ground when in use, as they vibrate and move when the motor is running
